

TOPIC: REVIVAL, RESTORATION AND RESSURECTION

Bible Reading - Psalm 85 v 1 to 9

Revival

To revive means to bring back to life. Whoever is to be revived must have died.

Restoration

To restore implies to renew and return back to the original state.

Resurrection

Resurrection is the process of coming back to life after death. The death and resurrection of Jesus Christ is the central thesis of Christianity. 1Corinthians 15: 12, 13,14

Revival

What we normally call revival where miracles and healing take place are merely the processes of revival. Revival itself implies a change in one's way of life towards restoration to what God designed you to be.

Some Great Revival in the Bible.

Exodus 33 v 1 - 4

1. The Israelites committed a grievous offence by making gods for themselves through Aaron. God still wanted them to go to the promised land but He was not to go with them. Moses knew the implication of going without God. The people stripped off their ornaments at Mount Horeb. That was a revival.

2. At the time of Samuel, he promised to make God first in the life of the Israelites. He destroyed all idols obstructing the people from serving God. This was a form of revival. 1 Sam 7 v 2 to 13

Do you still have some idols that you worship? Maybe not in the sense of the Israelites. Is it money? Is it your work? Is it your gadget?

Prayer.

That God will destroy all the gods obstructing us from serving God?

3. The Ark of Covenant was brought to Israel, led by King David, to Jerusalem. It was recorded as a revival. 2 Sam 6. A Church may require revival at one time or the other. The people should genuine repent and ask God to forgive and they also must change from their ways.

4. Jehoshaphat decided to trust God to help his people. This was because the people were already discouraged. This was a form of revival. 2 Chronicle 20. As they began to sing and praise, the Lord set ambushes against the men of Ammon and Moab and Mount Seir who were invading Judah and they were defeated.

Prayer. As you bring to sing praises in your heart, the Lord will set ambushes for the Ammon and Moab and Mount Seir who invading your lives and they will be defeated in Jesus Name. Amen.

Your enemies will destroy themselves in Jesus Name,

5. King Hezekiah purified the temple. 2 Chronicle 29 v 1. Hezekiah was just 25 when he became king and he reigned in Jerusalem for 29 years. Abijah, daughter of Zechariah was his mother. Hezekiah did what was right in the eyes of the Lord, just as his father David had done. .. The priests went into the sanctuary of the Lord to purify it. It was a great spiritual revival.

Jesus Christ also purified the or cleansed the temple.

You are a member in your Church. You have not been paying your tithes for one reason or the other. You can ask God for forgiveness and go into a revival by and start paying full tithes.

6. What about the heroes who are fallen? Those backsliding? Revelation 3 v 15 to 17. The angel of the church in Laodicea had this admonition. Neither cold nor hot. Meanwhile they thought they were rich and did not require anything. God said he would vomit them out of his mouth. They are wretched pitiful poor blind and naked.

7. The Revival of 1930 is known to every CAC member. In that revival many gods were destroyed, many habits were stopped and many customs were abandoned. People brought their charm idols voluntarily and they were destroyed. The God of our father performed wonders. The Lord gave three palm leaves to Apostle Babalola that he used to identify how he would treat those who believe in his ministry. How are we today? Our Last Vigil was a revival. What are the marks of God with us? Have we lost our signs? Get back our signs.

Restoration

Having being revived, you need to be properly restored to your original state. Psalm 80 v 19. Restore us, O Lord God of Host, Cause your face to shine and we shall be saved.

Resurrection

...and we shall be saved. What is salvation? There will be resurrection but where will you be after? Where will your home be after resurrection? Heaven or Hell? If you truly are a Christian and have lived your life, following the narrow path, surely, you will be on your way to your heavenly home. 2 Corinthians 5. (1-5)

Just like miracles and healing during revival, and the light that shines on us during restoration, gifts of the spirits are just mere vehicles. Hebrew 13 v 14 defines our home and we need to find out what to avoid in Galatians 5 v 17. Acts of Flesh in 19 - 21 and Acts of Spirit in 22 and 23.

Conclusion

Why the Home is important.

1. All deposits we make to that place are safe. Matthew 6 v 20. Store yourselves treasures in heaven.
2. John 16 v 2. There is a building waiting for everybody there.
3. Luke 10 v 20. Your name will be written in heaven.
4. Glorified Christ is already there waiting for you. Acts 7 v 55 and 56.
5. It is not a man-made house so it cannot be destroyed. Christ is the light.
6. Rev 7 v 9 to 11. Where we worship God in his majesty.

How do you get there?

2. Those who worship God with fear.
3. Those who do not value the world.
4. Those who are led by the Holy Spirit.
5. Those who walk on the narrow path.
