DEFINITIONS

JUVENILE Means : a young person who is not up to the legal age (18) mostly age 10-17 referred to as a '**MINOR**'

Children between Ages 1-10 are mainly referred to as **Children**

DELIQUENCY Means: **Committing of crime**

JUVENILE DELIQUENCY Means:

a. **A young person who regularly commits crime.**

b. **Illegal behaviour of a minor.**

A juvenile delinquent child, to the parents, is a **broken arrow**.

SCHOOL

- Bad Peer group.
- Indiscipline.
- Poor school performance.
- no supervision- school and class teacher.

SOCIETY

Society - We live with/among people-some of them may be extremely bad. In some society, children may pick bad habits such as smoking, drug abuse and many immoralities which may make them delinquent

SIGNS OF JUVENILE DELINQUENCY

- 1 Chronic violation of rules.
- 2 Serious aggression to others, parents, siblings, family, students even teachers.
- 3 Pride- lack of humility./ Rudeness.
- 4 Lack of respect for life(Parents, teachers, elders) and properties.
- 5 Truancy- staying away from school or church without reasons and parents knowledge.
- 6 Indiscipline generally

Juvenile delinquency affects

- 1- The child
- 2 -The family
- 3- The society at large

Government have a way of dealing with JUVENILE DELIQUENT CHILDREN

- 1- Remand Homes
- 2- Prison for grave offences but they are kept in MINOR section.
